

The readings give examples to theories helping you to understand the material in a more concrete manner. Study questions at the end give you another way to gauge whether you understand the core concepts in the chapters. I found the reading to be a little cumbersome, but what textbook isn't? Overall it gives a good foundation to understand OT's role in the promotion of health and wellness. They do provide pictures of the different models used and try to explain concepts and then give examples that might further help your understanding.
