

I was reluctant to purchase a \$300 book without reading through it first, but now that I took the plunge and purchased it, I'm ecstatic about it. It's probably the most comprehensive OMFS resource that comprehensively covers traditional OMFS as well as broader scope elements like cosmetics, head & neck, and cleft/craniofacial. The text is organized in a clear and concise manner, and it has relevant surgical illustrations that are very helpful.

The only flaw in this book is that it comes in one gargantuan book instead of in two volumes. I would have been willing to pay a little more to have this textbook divided into two books for ease-of-carry. Any other medical text this size would probably be divided. This thing is a monster and is meant to sit on your desk or shelf.I'm a practicing otolaryngologist, but this is a great reference for me to educate myself on what my oral surgeon colleagues are dealing with in the head and neck. An outstanding text.
